- Corrected: Disable "Auto Firmware Upgrade" due to MITM attack security.
- Improved: Remove the drop down list for the WDS Phy Mode option on Wireless LAN(2.4GHz)>>General Setup.
- Corrected: DHCP server offered service for the request which is not its own.
- Corrected: MAC information on Syslog was disappeared when a Wi-Fi client connected to VigorFly210 by WPA2/PSK.
- Corrected: With the feature of External Device offered by Vigor router (e.g, Vigor2860), the external device status would not display correctly by unplugging and plugging VigorFly from and onto Vigor router.
- Improved: Enhanced for SSLv3 Fallback protection.
- Improved: After rebooting, VigorAP can not auto update time from NTP server.
- Improved: Daylight saving is incorrect for AU and NZ.
- Improved: After pressing **OK** button on **Wireless LAN** >> **General Setup**, WAN will reconnect.
